Duplex printing:

- English professors are okay with double sided printing but many don't know how to do it
- John Vanderbrick of IT says that duplex printing is not the default setting because when it was in the past more copies were thrown out because students were not expecting them to be double sided
- new printers do have the duplex setting but have to wait until the old ones break down before they will be replaced with duplex capable machines

Power Point handouts: Mark made up copies of a “How to” sheet for printing multiple slides per page in Power Point, it remains to be decided what to do with these handouts

Recyclemania:

- poster in the CUB for advertising, possibly a large piece of hanging art to show how many people are involved
- university radio station advertisement
- maybe get an event ad on the ship.edu webpage
