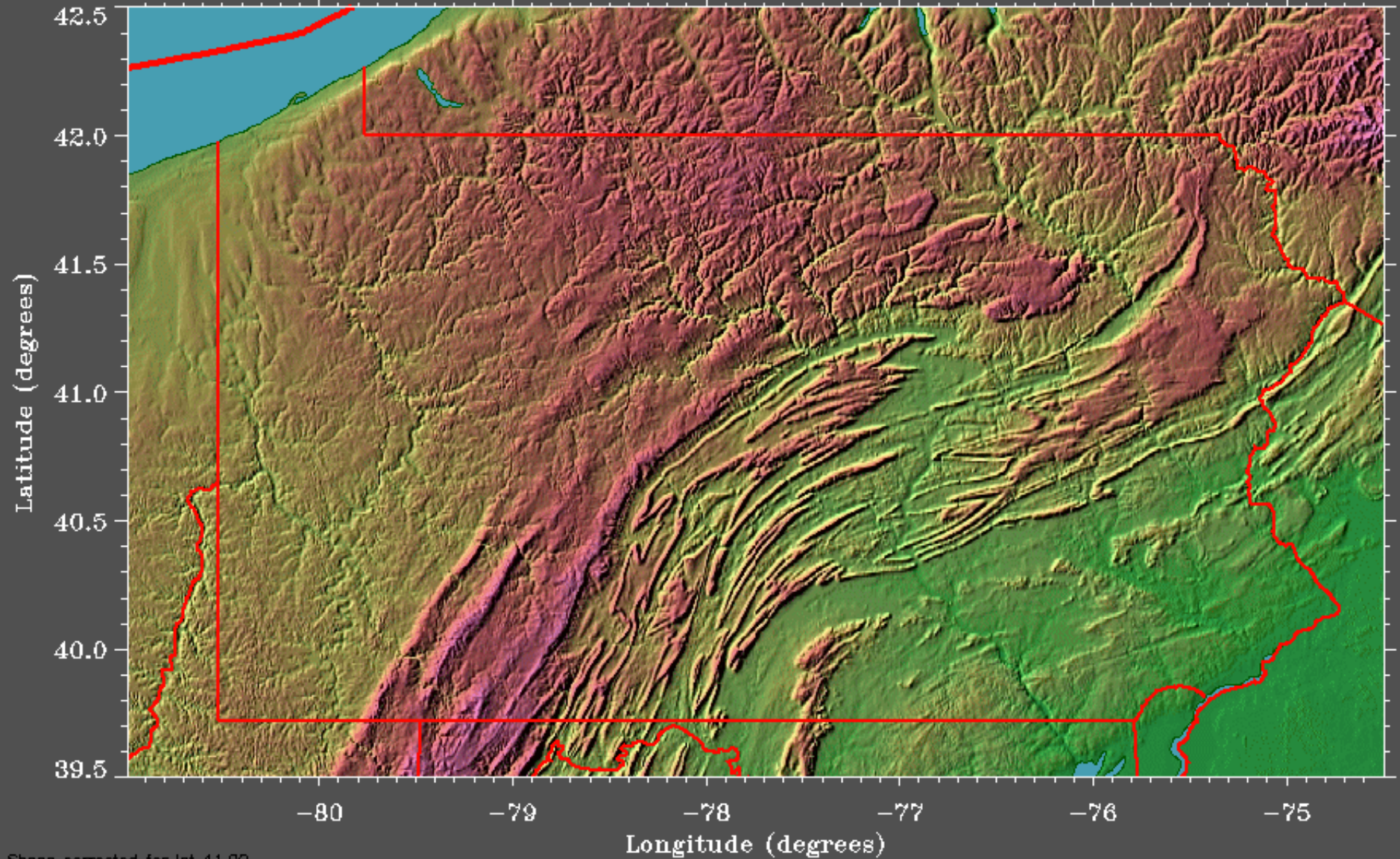


# PA Relief Map

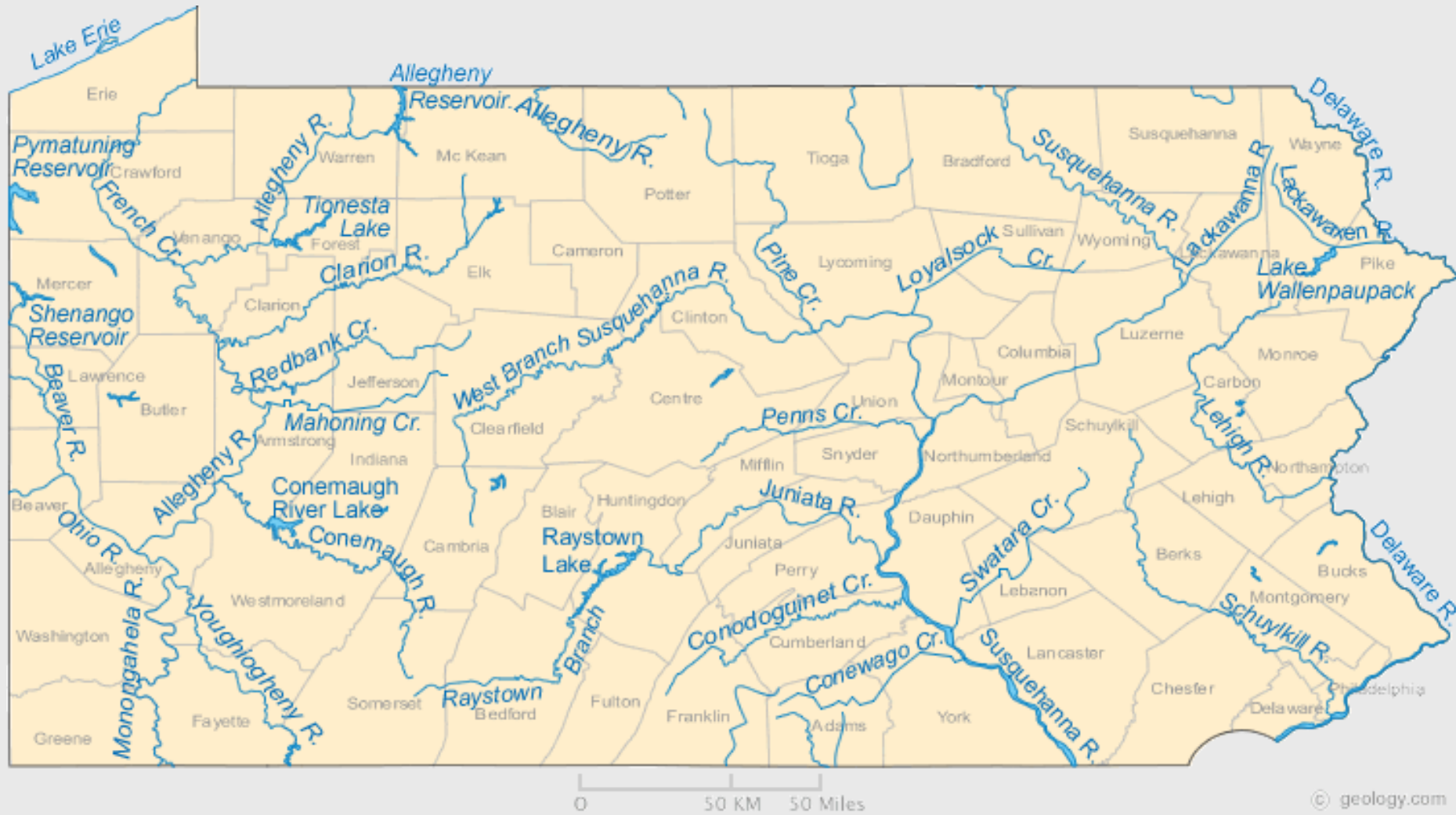

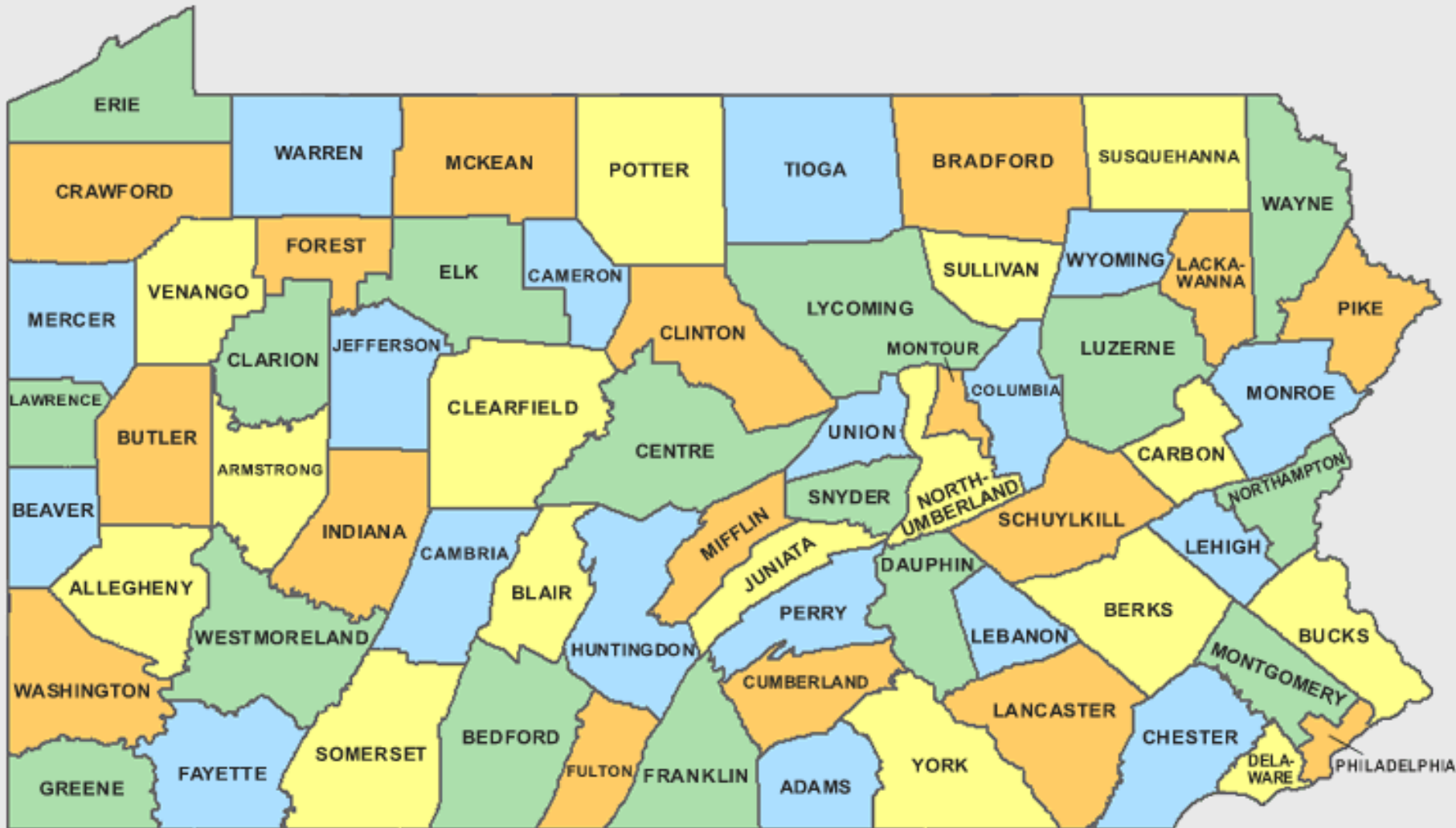
# PA Elevation Map

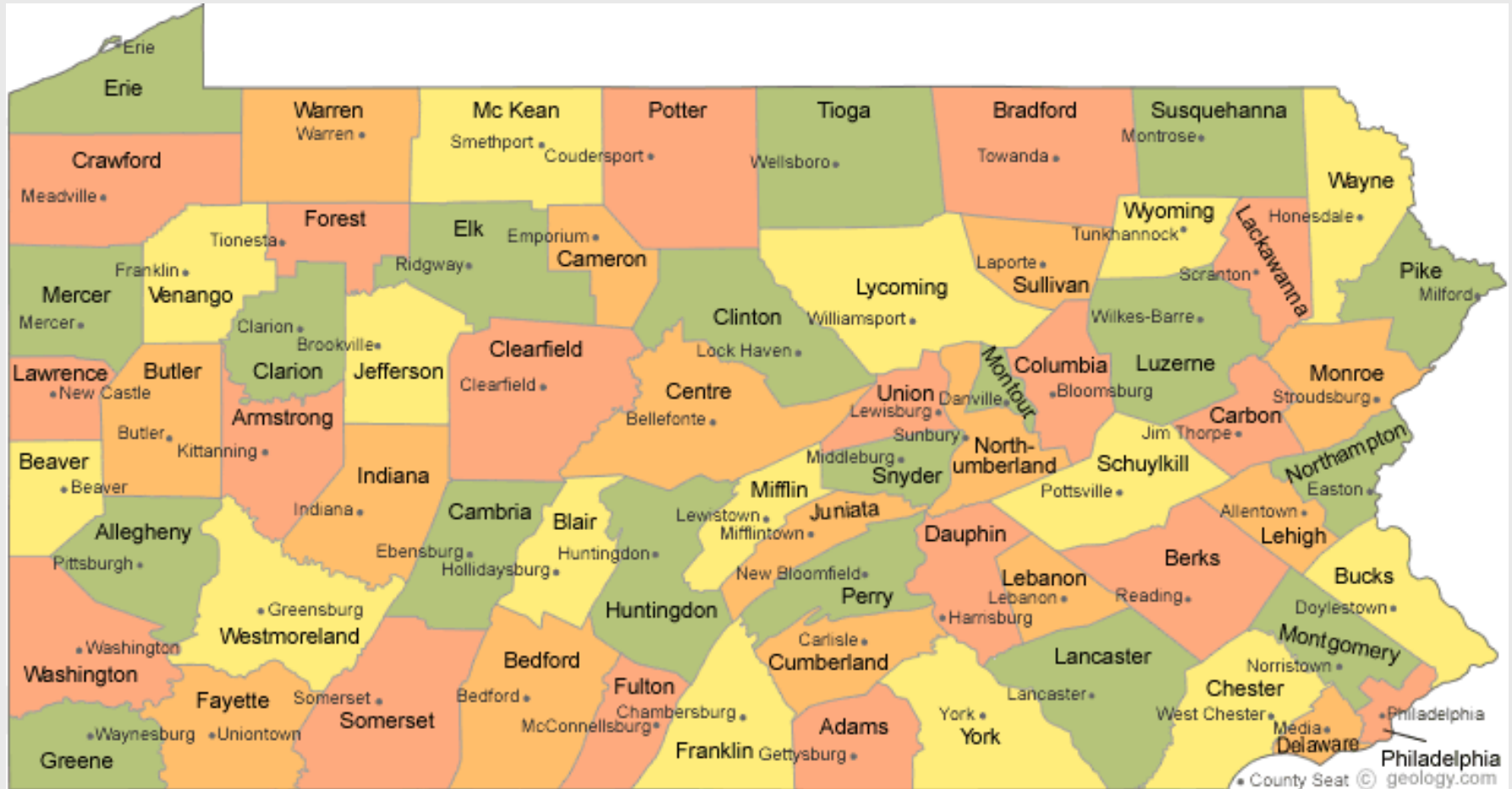

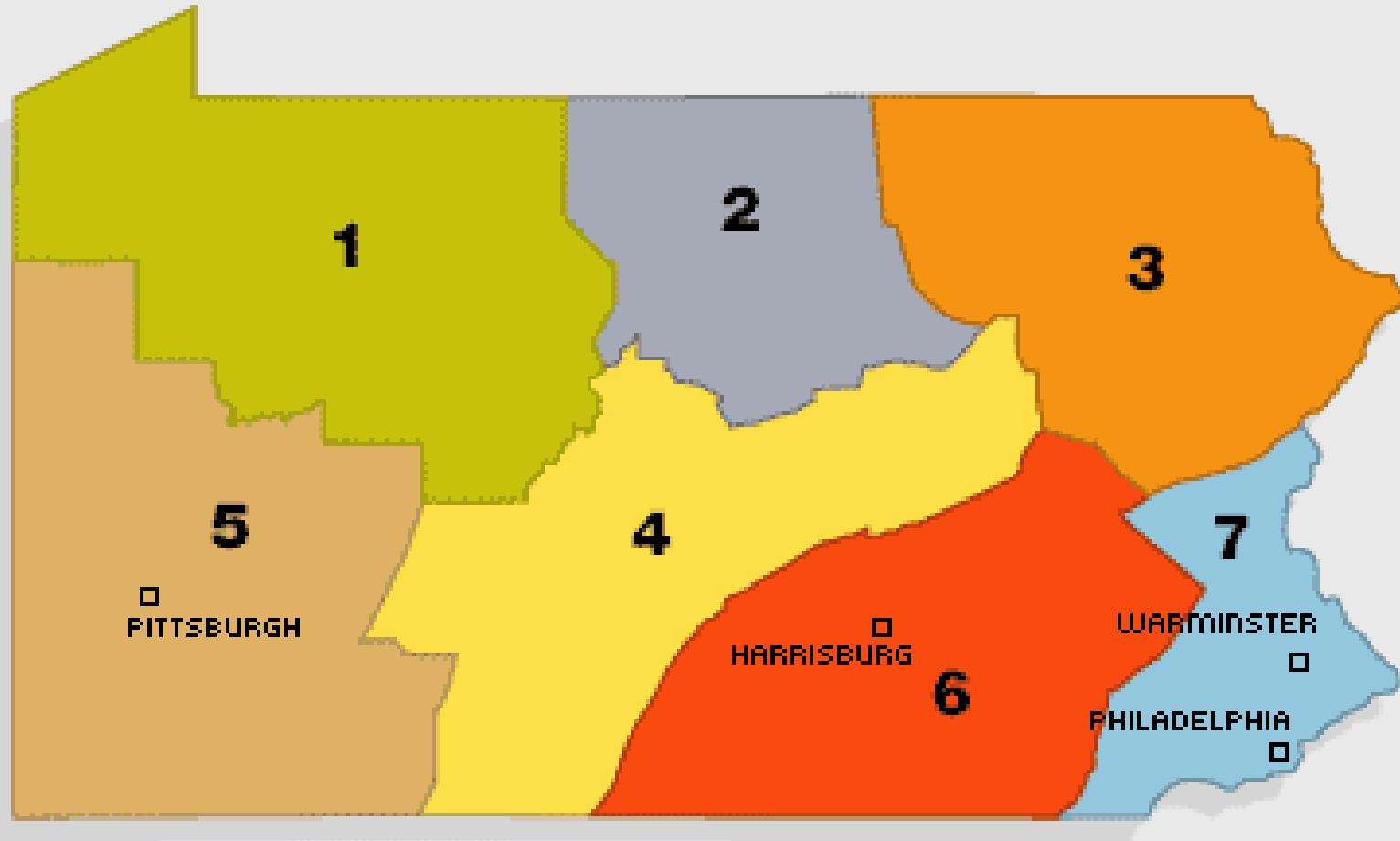


# PA County Map with County Seats

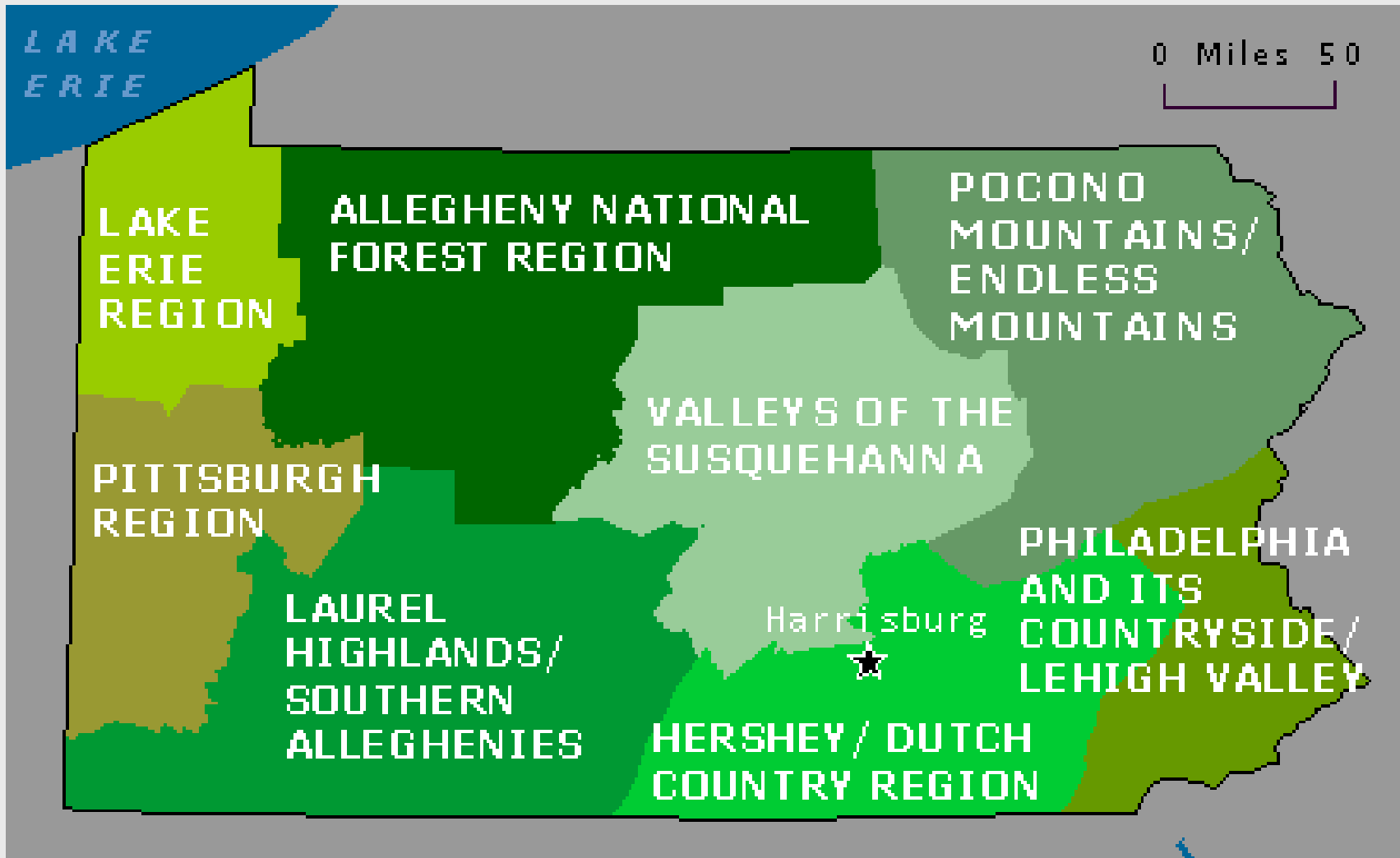

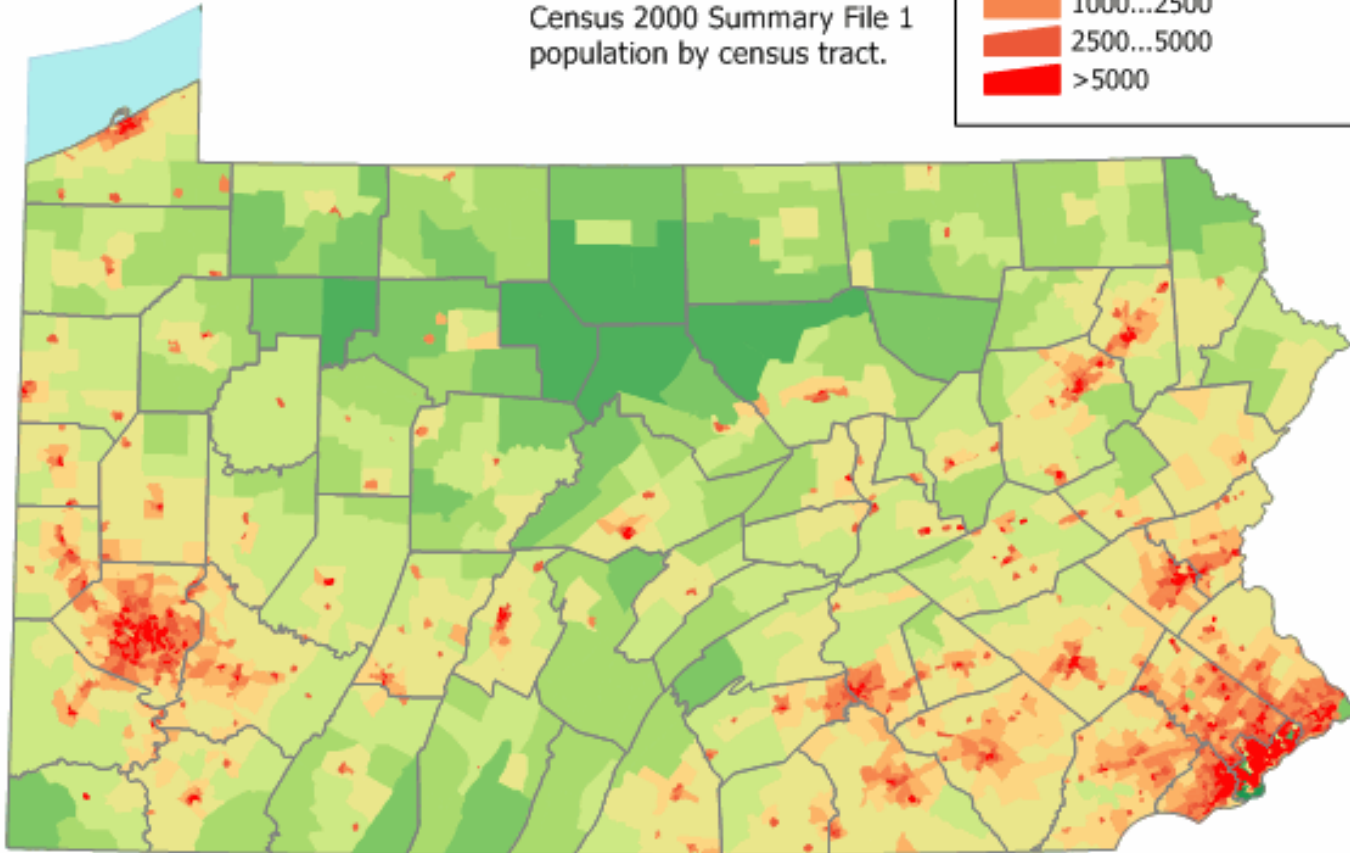

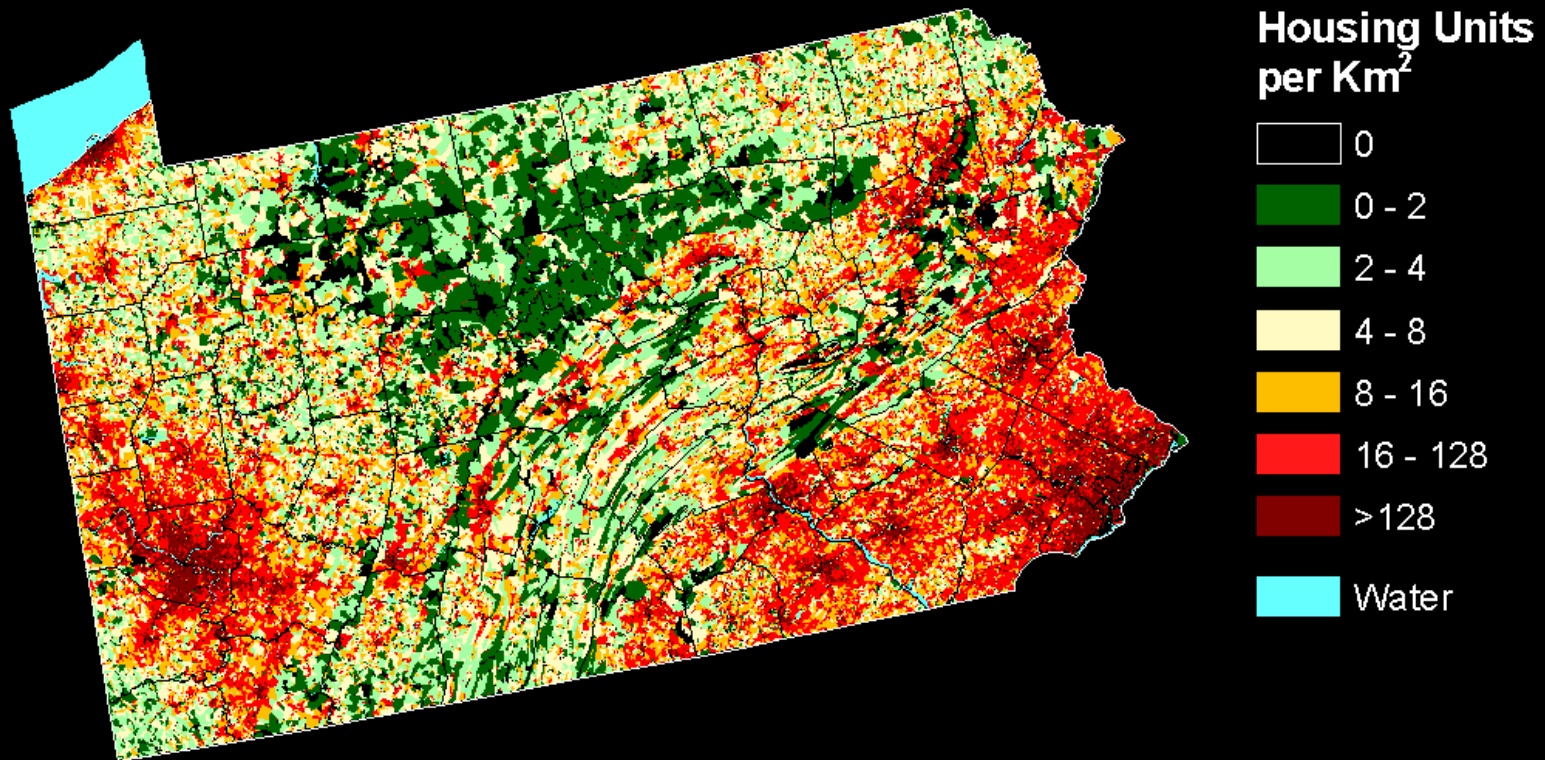

Housing Density: Census Block 2000

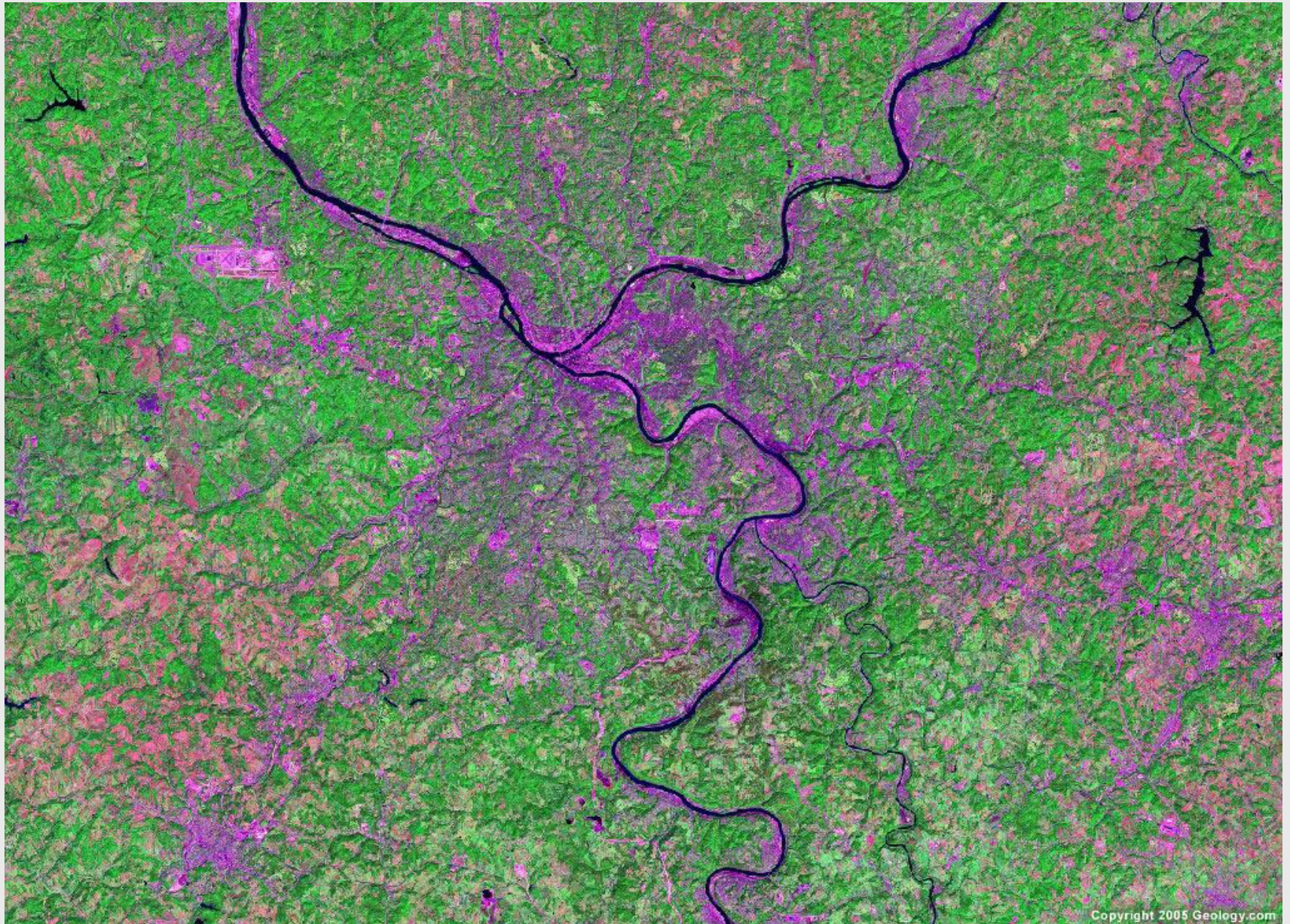

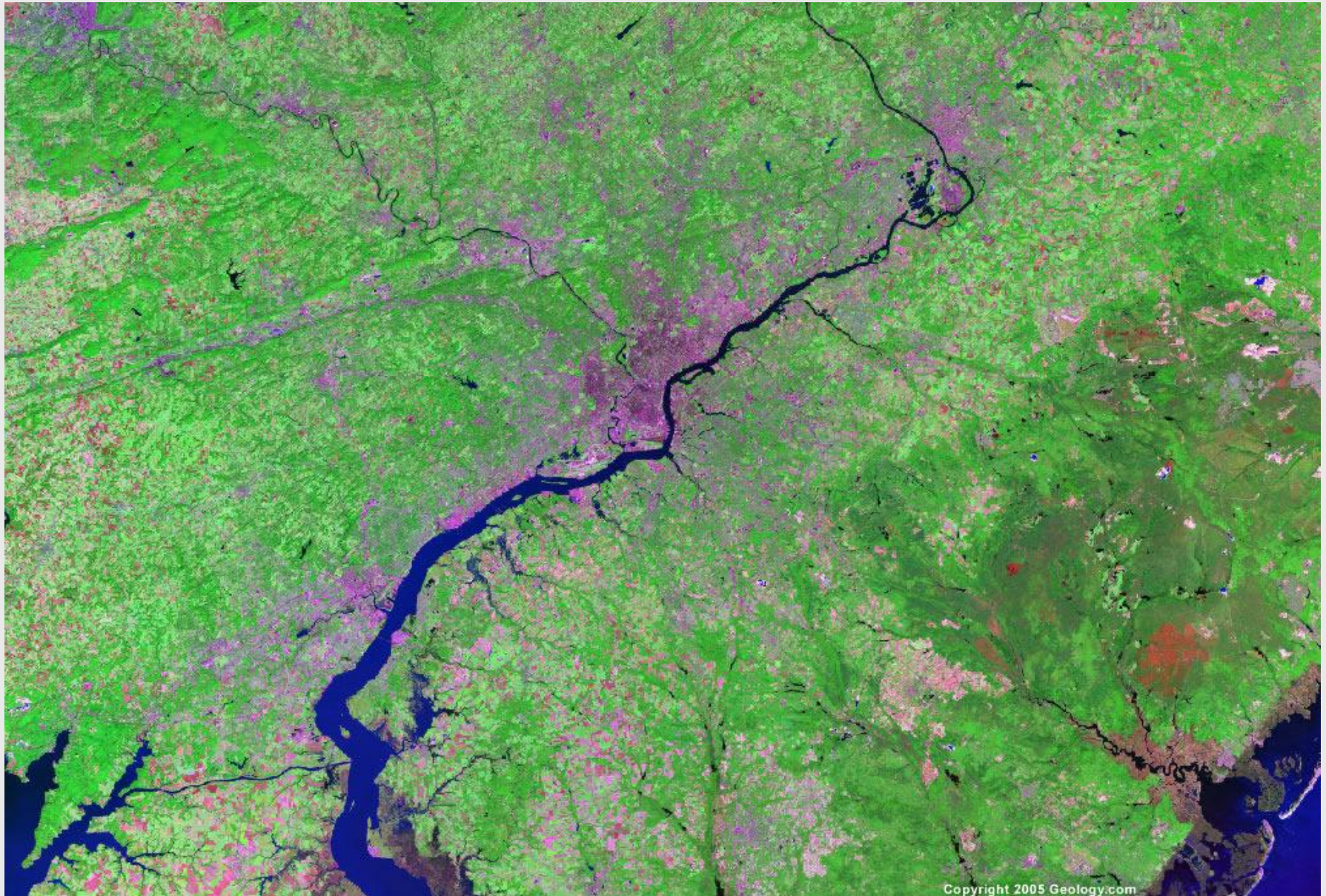

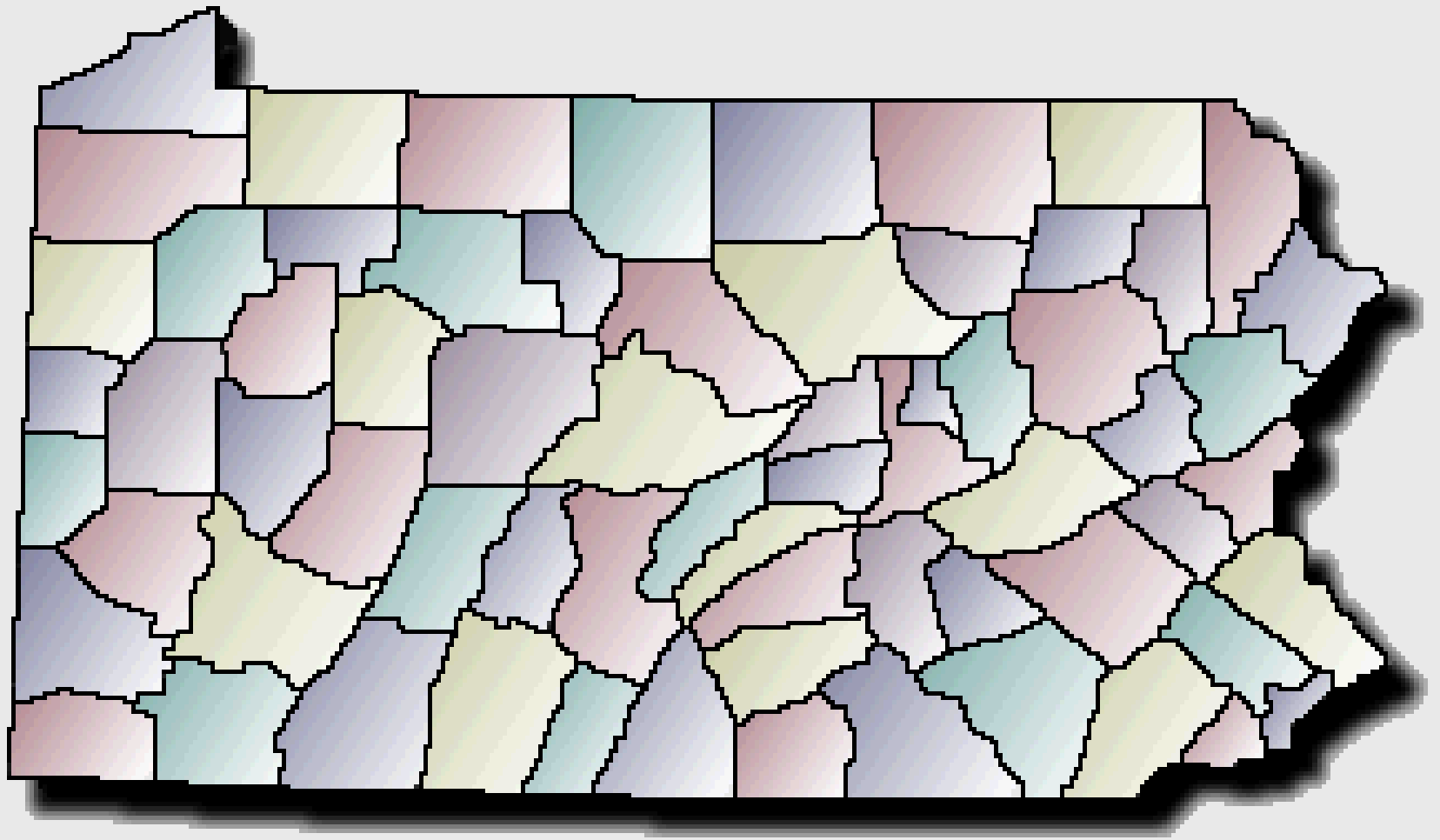
**LITERARY NOTES**
