Automatic Searching Strategies

- The core concept of automatic search is that the user defines the search purpose and search scope, and let the machine (search engine) search automatically.
- The “machine” will send back the search results to the subscriber through email or by other means in a frequency as the user pre-determines or as the search engine defines.
