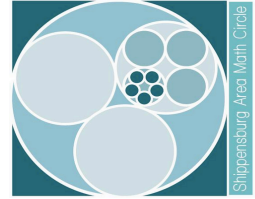
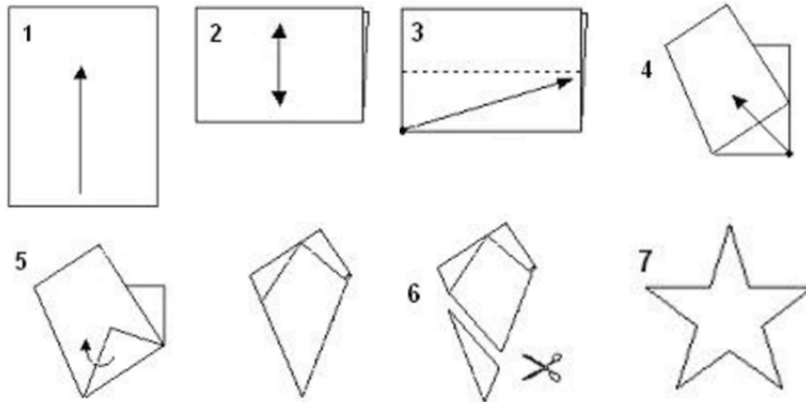


One-Cut Kirigami

The instructions below show how to fold a 8.5 in. by 11 in. piece of paper to make a five-pointed star (like a star on the American flag) with one cut.



1. Try using one cut to make various polygons like a triangle, square, and pentagon.
2. Try using one cut to make various letters of the alphabet like T, t, I, and i.
