Note that grades are determined to 1 decimal place and rounded up to the next whole number.

Grade	Point Range (out of 100)
A	94 - 100
A-	90 - 93
B+	87 - 89
B	84 - 86
B-	80 - 83
C+	77 - 79
C	70 - 76
D	60 - 69
F	59 or lower

Special Grades

- F* Administrative F. Given when a student stop attending classes but has not dropped the course. Reverts to an F when grades are posted.
- I Incomplete. Given if you are unable to complete the course due to illness, death in the immediate family, or personal emergency. All course material must be completed by the end of the next semester (or summer) or the incomplete will revert to an F. Requests for an incomplete are made through the individual faculty member or the dean.
- Q A deferred grade. Only given when the student is taking a course which spans more than one semester, such as research courses or thesis.
- S / U Satisfactory / unsatisfactory. This is essentially a Pass-Fail option. Please refer the Undergraduate Catalog (pp. 34-35) for more information.
